POLICY

Parent & Family Engagement

University Preparatory Charter School for Young Men(UPREP) in Rochester, NY recognizes the vital role of parents in their children's education and is committed to fostering meaningful engagement. Our Parent & Engagement Policy aims to create a collaborative environment that supports student success.

1. Communication

- 1.1 The school shall maintain open and transparent communication channels with parents.
- 1.2 A user-friendly online platform shall be provided for parents to access student information, grades, and school announcements.
- 1.3 Monthly/Quarterly newsletters shall be distributed to all parents, highlighting student achievements, upcoming events, and important school information.
- 1.4 Regular email blasts shall be sent to keep parents informed about school events, updates, and important announcements.

2. Parent-Teacher Conferences
